NATURE SCIENCE INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME



Indian Institute of Science (Centre for Ecological Sciences) in collaboration with Adanya Chetana an NGO, conducted an Internship Programme for school students. Eight students studying in Std VIII were chosen as interns. The Nature Science Internship Programme intends to give a bird's eye view of using outdoor clues to evaluate water and soil quality and determine carbon footprint.

During the five month period of intensive study the students studied trees, birds, butterflies, carbon sequestration and calculated the oxygen produced by the trees.

The dissolved oxygen of the water sample from Kagadapura lake was calculated. The algae present in the polluted water sample was analysed. The students visited the New Horizon College of Engineering campus to understand the procedures involved in the sewage treatment plant, rain water harvesting and composting units.


A power point presentation was given by the students on 18th and 19th November, 2017 at the IISc campus, where they were questioned by Dr T V Ramachandra, a senior scientist from IISc.
